

Stadion Core Advantage Portfolio Fact Sheet- Class I Shares 1/31/12

Investment Objective

The investment objective of the Stadion Core Advantage Portfolio (the "Fund") is to seek capital appreciation.

Investment Strategy

The Stadion funds are publicly traded mutual funds managed by Stadion Money Management, LLC. The Fund is actively managed investing primarily in Exchange Traded Funds, or ETFs.

Stadion seeks to achieve the Fund's objective by attempting to participate in gains when stock market conditions appear favorable and by reducing exposure when stock market conditions appear less favorable.

Investment Risks

Investment in the Fund is subject to investment risks, including, without limitation, market risk, management style risk, risks related to "fund of funds" structure, sector risk, fixed income risk, tracking risk, risks related to ETF net asset value and market price, foreign securities risk, risks related to portfolio turnover and small capitalization companies risk. Since the Fund is a "fund of funds," an investor will indirectly bear fees and expenses charged by the underlying ETFs and investment companies in which the Fund invests in addition to the Fund's direct fees and expenses. +The Advisor has entered into an Expense Limitation Agreement with the Fund under which it has agreed to waive or reduce its fees and to assume other expenses of the Fund, if necessary, in an amount that limits the Fund's annual operating expenses (exclusive of interest, taxes, brokerage commissions, extraordinary expenses, Acquired Fund Fees and Expenses and payments, if any, under the Rule 12b-1 Plan) to not more than 1.70% of average daily net assets until October 1, 2012. It is expected that the Expense Limitation Agreement will continue from year-to-year, provided continuance is approved by the Board of Trustees. The Fund's performance has been positively impacted by the Expense Limitation Agreement. The Expense Ratios listed above do not include Acquired Fund Fees and Expenses, which are the fees and expenses incurred indirectly by the Fund as a result of its investments during the most recent fiscal year in investment companies and other pooled investment vehicles. For the Stadion Core Advantage Portfolio, Acquired Fund Fees and Expenses were 0.24% of the Fund's average daily net assets for the fiscal year ended May 31, 2011. The Current Expense Ratio is the expense ratio as a percentage of the Fund's average daily net assets as of the date listed above. The Current Expense Ratio may fluctuate based upon a number of factors, including changes in the Fund's net assets.

The index shown is defined as follows. The S&P 500 Index is the Standard & Poor's Composite Index of 500 stocks and is a widely recognized, unmanaged index of common stock prices. All Benchmarks composite data supplied by third party vendors, assumes re-investment of all dividends.
